



Erbyn diwedd eu hamser yn Ysgol Gymraeg Ystalyfera Bro Dur, bydd eich plentyn yn:





Iechyd a Lles


Mae Iechyd a Lles yn faes sy'n ganolog i'r weledigaeth sydd gen-hym ar gyfer ein disgyblion.





Cefnogi Cynnydd Dysgwyr

Reviewing our Curriculum



Maintaining a strong partnership between school and home is important to help your child to make progress.

We will share information with you about your child's progress through reports, parents' evenings and by uploading pupil work to the Seesaw app.

Supporting Pupil Progress

Ensuring that pupils make progress in their skills, knowledge and understanding is a key element of our curriculum.

To ensure that your child makes effective progress, we plan carefully across the learning programme to increase and develop the level of challenge of skills and depth of knowledge.

We also plan for progress within lessons by ensuring that we know what your child can do already (assessment);

- What they need to do to move on to the next steps and improve (planning);
- How we can support them to improve (teaching).

- Written feedback and opportunities to improve work
- Using success criteria
- Self assessment and taking responsibility for their own work
- Peer assessment




We have invested time and resources into developing our outdoor areas and also our Forest School programme which has had much positive feedback from our learners.



We can ensure this through use of our outdoor area and through visits and enrichment experiences. The ability to take measured risks and developing independent learners

are key elements of the Curriculum for Wales and this can be supported through outdoor learning. A large element of becoming responsible citizens stems from learning about nature and our impact on the natural world. It is imperative that our children and young people gain experiences outdoors in order to achieve this. One Area of Learning in Curriculum for Wales is Health and Well-being, where there is a great focus on the outdoors in order to promote mental health and well-being; generally to promote health gains and confidence in children and young people.
