Dear Parent / Guardian,

As we approach the Christmas holidays, I would like to thank you all for your support during what has been a busy and at times, challenging term. However, due to the hard work of our learners and staff and your constant co-operation, support and communication - we have been able to provide a full term of valuable learning and experiences for our learners.

You may be aware that the Minister for Education announced changes to the start of the Spring term yesterday. In order to ensure sufficient time for schools to identify and evaluate the situation in January, the Government has announced that there will be **two preparation days** at the beginning of term for schools when the school will only be open for staff to assess and prepare. Therefore, the Spring Term will begin for **all learners on January 6th** (Thursday).

When the learners return, they will stay in year bubbles and all learners are expected to arrive at school with a mask.
