Attendance, Punctuality and COVID-19

It has been a challenging time with regard to attendance, and we would like to thank you for working with us with regard to our COVID-19 safety protocols, and other illnesses, which of course continue to be in place. Having said this, we are all acutely aware of how much school our pupils have missed and wish for all pupils to attend school whenever they are able to do so in order to reach their individual attendance target of 95%. Achieving this target wherever possible ensures that pupils are able to progress and access the school Curriculum as a whole.
