Annwyl Riant / Warcheidwad,

Rydych yn barod wedi gweld 'wythnos profiad gwaith bl12' (wythnos yn dechrau 13/06/22) yn ymddangos ar ein cylchlythyr diwedd tymor, a hoffwn ehangu ar y wybodaeth sydd ynddo.

- 1) Peidiwch beco os nad ydych wedi trefnu rhywbeth ar gyfer yr wythnos penodol, gallwch drefnu rhywbeth ar gyfer gwyliau'r Haf neu blwyddyn nesaf. Canolbwyntiwch ar eich arholiadau/asesiadau am nawr.
- 2) OS CHI'N MEDDWL BOD YN DDOCTOR, DEINTYDD, MILFEDDYG, NYRS, GWEITHIWR CYMDEITHASOL neu unrhywbeth arall yn y maes gofal, RHAI BOD CHI'N GWNEUD PROFIAD GWAITH PERTHNASOL ER MWYN I'R PRIFYSGOLION YSTYRIED EICH CAIS. Ar gyfer meddygaeth, milfeddygaeth, deintyddiaeth bydd raid i'ch cais UCAS fod mewn erbyn Hydref 15fed felly rhaid trefnu cynnod cyn hyn. Mwy o brofiad sydd gennych, gorau gyd!
- 3) Os oes swydd rhan amser gyda chi, mae'n iawn defnyddio hwn fel profiad ond dyle chi ofyn am weld agwedd arall o'r swydd hefyd (os yn bosib)
- 4) Does dim rhaid gwneud wythnos llawn ond o leiaf 2 diwrnod

Dear Parent / Guardian,

You have already seen 'year 12 work experience week' (week beginning 13/06/22), appear on our end of term newsletter and I'd like to expand on the information it contains.

With things now returning to normality, universities and workplaces are looking for young people with life experiences and skills. Good grades are not enough to get a place and work experience is a great way to gain these experiences and develop skills.

The experience can be anything - hours in the local shop, going to work with a family member or something relevant to the career they are considering.

Here are a couple of points the pupils have already received on TEAMS this week:

1) Don't worry if you haven't organised something for that specific week, you can arrange something for the Summer holidays or next year. Focus on your exams / assessments for now.

2) IF YOU ARE THINKING OF BECOMING A DOCTOR, DENTIST, VET, NURSE, SOCIAL WORKER or anything else in the field of care, YOU MUST HAVE RELEVANT WORK EXPERIENCE FOR THE UNIVERSITY TO CONSIDER YOUR APPLICATION. For medicine, veterinary medicine and dentistry, your UCAS application must be in by October 15th therefore something needs to be organised before then. The more experience you have, the better your chances!

3) If you have a part-time job, it's fine to use this as work experience but you should ask to see another aspect of the job as well (if possible)

4) There is no need to do a full week however a minimum of 2 days is required.
