Bydd gofyn i aelodau staff sydd ddim yn cymryd rhan yn y streic ddarparu gwaith ar-lein drwy TEAMS i ddisgyblion blynnyddoedd 7-11 a byddwn yn gofyn i chi annog eich plentyn i gwblhau'r tasgau ar-lein hyn.

Dear Parent / Carer

Re: Teachers' strike Action

I am writing in regard to the **second** national strike involving the National Education Union [NEU] members planned for **Thursday March 2nd**. In accordance with national guidelines, we have undertaken a risk assessment to examine how a strike would impact on our ability to maintain normal school provision. Unfortunately, we have concluded that **we would be unable** to fully operate safely due to potential significant staff absence; as such, school will be **closed to pupils in years 7-11**; years **12 and 13 will attend as normal**. The decision to close the school or send pupils home is never taken lightly, but in this instance, where staff have elected to take lawful industrial action, I have had no choice but to take the appropriate steps to ensure the health, safety and wellbeing of all pupils.

Non-striking members of staff will be required to provide work on-line through TEAMS for pupils in years 7-11 and I would ask that you encourage your child to complete these online tasks.

Wales Under 18s Cup Thursday March 2nd 4.00p.m.

The Welsh Rugby Union has confirmed the game is on so this trip will continue. Whilst the school will be closed, we have arranged for the bus to collect pupils from specific points. Information on the pick-up locations of the bus will be shared with pupils on 28.2.23.
