Standards and Expectations;

Maintaining high standards in all aspects of school life is essential and I would like to take this opportunity to emphasise two messages:

1. Attendance:

As you know, attendance is a critically important focus for us in school because if your child isn't in school, they're not learning. For this term our attendance is **92.97%**. Our target for all pupils is a minimum of **95%** to give the best chance of reaching their full potential. We monitor weekly and if we are concerned about attendance percentages, we will get in touch for further discussion. We kindly ask you to work with us to ensure we reach our goal.

2. School Uniform:

The standard of uniform amongst some pupils is unacceptable: leggings, white socks, hoodies and trainers are not acceptable. After half term we will act firmly to ensure all pupils comply with our expectations. I'm sure you will agree with us that standards start with school uniform and that wearing the uniform is an honour that should be respected every day.
